CALL FOR ENTRY CATEGORIES

- 1. *Art Quilts* Must be of original form and composition. They can be abstract or pictorial.
- 2. *Wall Quilts from Patterns/Books/Workshops* Credit must be given to the published pattern, book or workshop.
- 3. **Bed Quilts from Patterns/Books/Workshops** Credit must be given to the published pattern, book or workshop
- 4. **Wall Quilts Original/Traditional** Can be totally original or based on traditional style piecing/applique using blocks that are in the public domain.
- 5. **Bed Quilts Original/Traditional** Can be totally original or based on traditional style piecing/applique using blocks that are in the public domain.
- 6. *Hand Quilted* Can be machine pieced or appliqued but the actual quilting must be by hand.
- 7. *Modern Wall or Bed Quilt* Depicts modern design features such as minimalism, asymmetry, negative space and alternate grid work. They may also feature improvisational piecing and solid fabrics. Quilts may be original or from published patterns, books or workshops.
- **8.** Wearables/Other Includes quilted articles which can be worn such as jackets or vests. Bags, purses and table runners are also included. They may be original or from a published pattern, book or workshop.
- 9. **Youth (18 or under by entry deadline)** May be quilts of any size, wearable art, or any quilted item. They may be original or from a published pattern, book or workshop.

Entries will not be judged. Viewers' Choice prizes will be awarded.

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Call for Entry Instructions

- 1. Entry fee is **\$8 per item**, maximum <u>four</u> entries per person. Please use a separate form for each item entered.
- 2. Entry forms, with photographs and an entry fee of \$8.00 per item payable to the Lethbridge Centennial Quilters Guild are to be received by **March 31, 2017.** If you submit your entry via e-mail, the entry fee must be paid at the March Guild meeting.
- 3. Entry forms are available from the LCQG website: <u>www.lethbridgequilters.ca/festival</u> You can scan your entry form and submit it via e-mail if you prefer.
- 4. Each quilt entry is to be accompanied by two good quality 4" x 6" photographs, one showing the full quilt filling the entire frame of the photo and the other the detail of the quilt. Photographs must show the quilt fully pieced with quilting in progress and are non-returnable. If you prefer, you can submit digital photos to entry@lethbridgequilters.ca Digital images must be in JPEG format, 3 Mpx (e.g., 2000px by 1500px approx. 1.5MB) or larger.
- 5. Each wearable art entry is to be accompanied by three good quality 4" x 6" photographs, one photo to show a front view, one to show a back view and one to show the detail of the item. If you prefer, you can submit digital photos to entry@lethbridgequilters.ca Digital images must be in JPEG format, 3 Mpx (e.g., 2000px by 1500px approx. 1.5MB) or larger.
- 6. Credit must be given to the author, teacher, artist, workshop, commercial pattern, etc., that inspired the work. Please include anyone who participated in the execution of the work e.g. if a long-arm machine quilter completed your quilt.
- 7. Entry item must have been completed since March 31, 2015.
- 8. All quilts must have a minimum three-inch sewn sleeve on the back to facilitate hanging as well as an identification label.
- 9. The LCQG Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entries. A limited number of large quilts can be hung due to space restrictions.
- 10. The perimeter of your quilt cannot exceed 436 inches.
- 11. All agents of The Lethbridge Centennial Quilters Guild will take every reasonable precaution to safeguard the show entries, but assume no responsibility in the unlikely event that an entry is lost or damaged. Entrants may want to consider having items appraised and insured through their own insurance policy.
- 12. If more than one item is entered, please indicate your preference for acceptance of your entries using #1 as your first choice, #2 as your second choice etc. Please indicate if you wish your entry designated for sale.
- 13. A Notification of Acceptance, combined with details for submission of quilts, will be sent to the applicant via email. If you have not received an e-mail by April 15, 2017 contact Kathy Oliver at entry@lethbridgequilters.ca.
