

Community Quilt 2017 - Jelly Roll Spin (Maie Wills)

Finished Size: approximately 40" x 48"



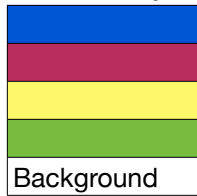
Fabric Requirements:

- One Jelly Roll or two 2 1/2" strips WOF of each colour you decide to use. (You need 52" of each colour so if you use two strips WOF you will have left overs)
- Fabric for background and one strip in Block A and 2 strips in Block B

These Fabric Requirements assume your strips are all WOF, but you can use any combination of colour and length of strips along as the finished blocks are 6 1/2" x 10 1/2"

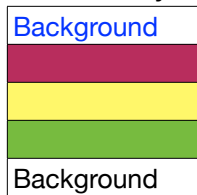
Instructions

Block A - you need 8 blocks



Sew the 2 1/2" strips into strip sets using 4 coloured strips and 1 strip of background fabric - the strip set should be 10 1/2" wide when all strips are sewn together.
Cut the strip set into 6 1/2" pieces. Each block should measure 6 1/2" x 10 1/2".

Block B - you need 8 blocks

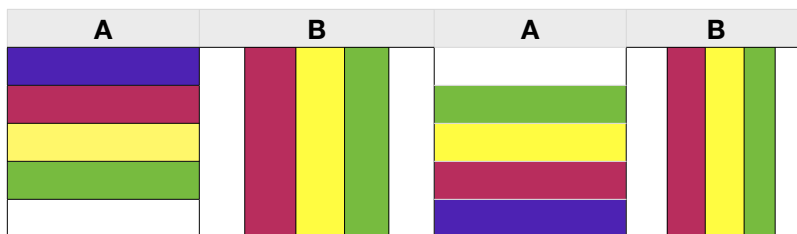


Sew the 2 1/2" strips into strip sets using 3 coloured strips and 2 strips of background fabric - the strip set should be 10 1/2" wide when all strips are sewn together.
Cut the strip set into 6 1/2" pieces. Each block should measure 6 1/2" x 10 1/2".

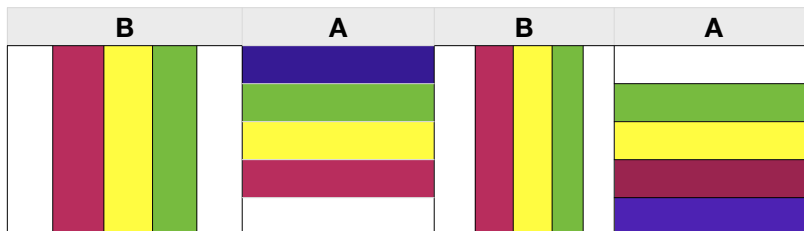
Background - Cut 8 strips of background fabric 4 1/2" wide and WOF

Sew the blocks together into 4 rows of 4 blocks -

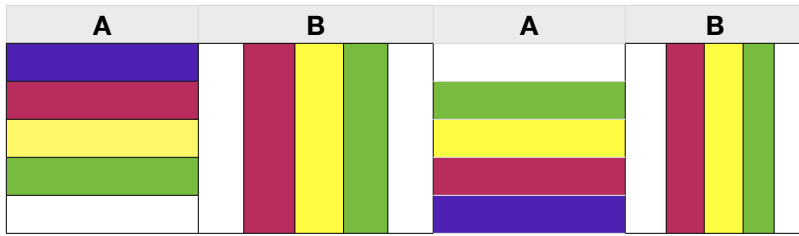
Two rows start with an A Block - A row. Note the rotation of the A blocks in the rows.



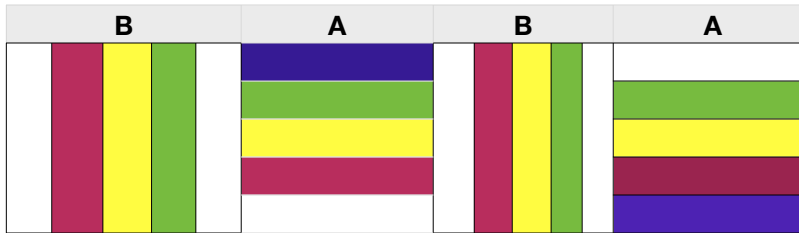
Two rows start with a B Block - B row



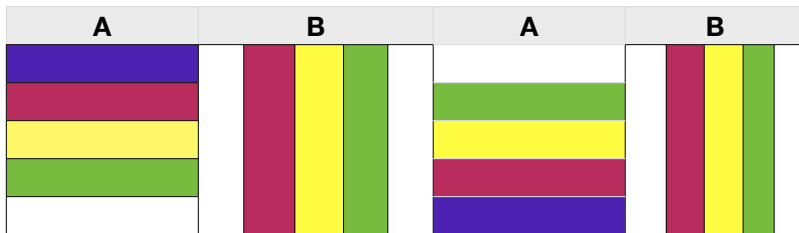
Join the rows together with a piece of background sashing between the rows. Make sure the rows alternate (A row, B row, A row, B row)



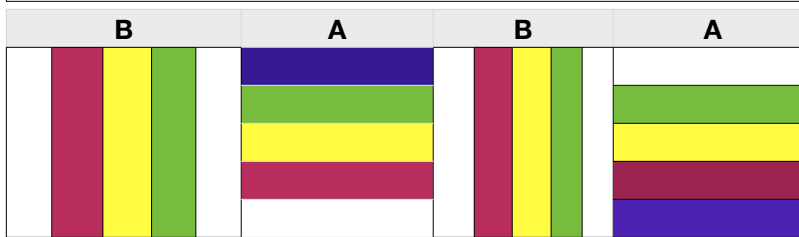
Sashing - background fabric
