

Community Quilt 2017- Falling Charms (adapted from Missouri Star Quilt Falling Charms)



This pattern is compatible with charm packs and jelly rolls

Finished Size - Approximately 38" x 58"

Unfinished Block size - 7" x 7"

Fabric Requirements:

- 54 - 5" squares (Time to use up those charm packs)
- 15 - 2 1/2" strips WOF (use a jelly roll or two) for background

Block Instructions:

1.Chain piece all the 5" squares to 2 1/2" strips. Cut apart. Press towards the smaller piece.

2.Chain piece the pieced unit from step 1 to the remaining 2 1/2" strips. Cut apart and press towards the 2 1/2" piece.

Quilt Layout:

3. Layout is 6 blocks in each row and 9 rows.

4.To help with placing blocks think of the point where the two 2 1/2" strips meet as the CORNER. Place the Corner as instructed below. (In the layout diagram, the dot represents where the strips meet).

Row 1 - corner **top right**, corner **bottom left**, corner **top right**, corner **bottom left**, corner **top right**, corner **bottom left**.

Row 2 - corner **bottom left**, corner **top right**, corner **bottom left**, corner **top right**, corner **bottom left**, corner **top right**

5.Continue alternating row 1 and row 2 until you have 9 rows.

6.The blocks should look like they are tumbling diagonally across the quilt.
